### Notes

In 1731 John DASHPER was recorded as owning a plantation in Augusta County of the then Colony of Virginia. His descendants modified their surname and there is now a substantial Virginia clan of DESPERs in the USA. It is believed that James DASHPER (born 1812) had a falling out with his father, William, as a result of which he changed his name to DASHFORD. Some of his descendants retained the name DASHFORD, others reverted to DASHPER. To my knowledge DASHFORD has not been researched through the RGO records.

Poor folk often dodged church fees by not recording events.
